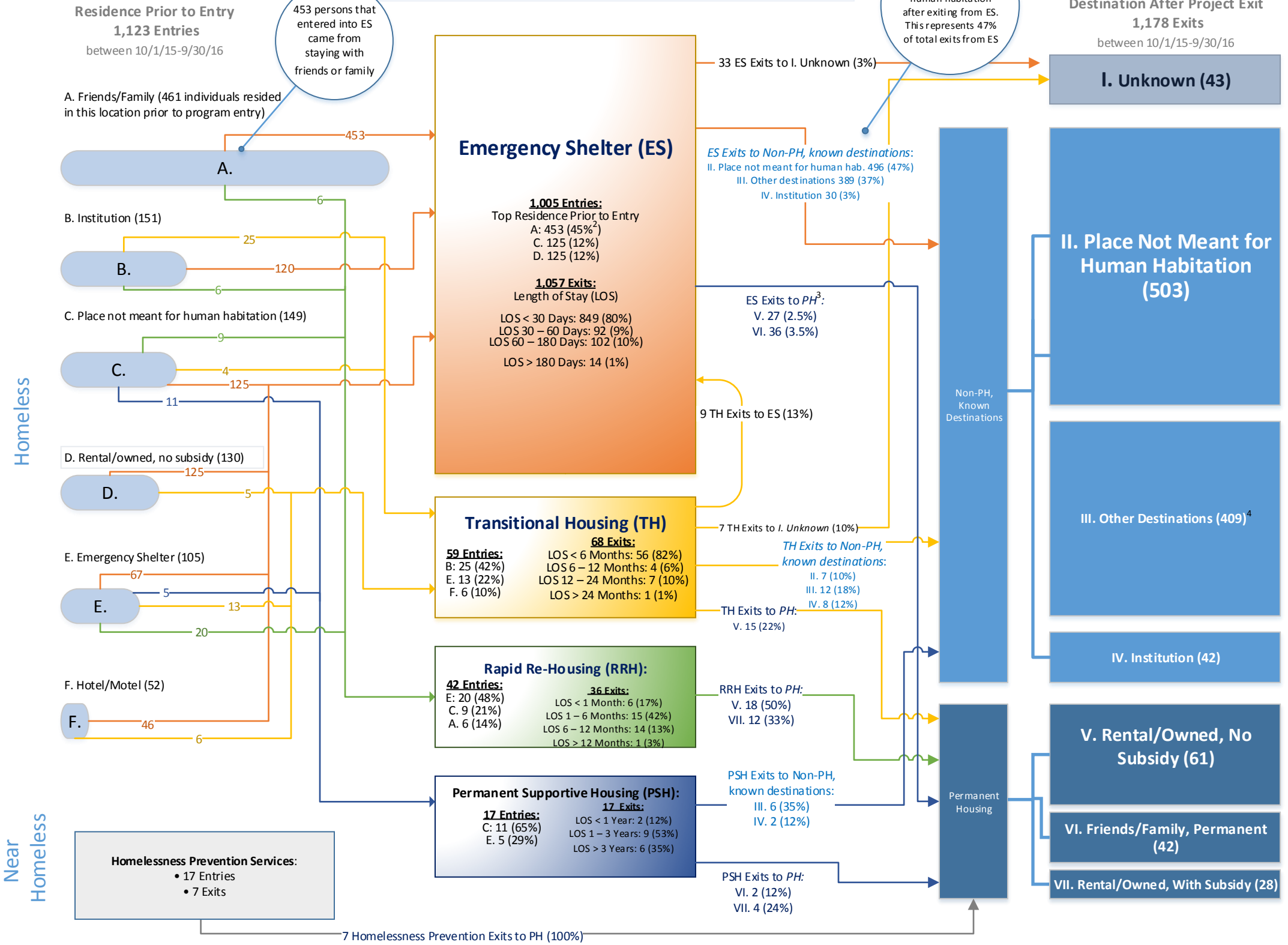


Alaska Balance of State Regional Systems Map: Fairbanks¹

Time Period: October 1, 2015 – September 30, 2016



FOOTNOTES:

- ¹ The systems map does not include data from designated HAP or BHAP programs, as the data could not distinguish between ES, TH, RRH, or PSH characteristics of each HAP or BHAP program. There were 367 entries from HAP or BHAP programs.
- ² All percentages on this map represent the percent of persons that entered or exited from each type of program: ES, TH, RRH, and PSH (e.g., Out of the 1,005 entries in ES, 453 people, or 45%, came from staying with friends or family).
- ³ In general, data that accounts for less than 10% of the total number of entries or exits per program is not graphically represented on this map, unless it was intentionally added to show significance (e.g., Emergency shelter (ES) exits to rental/owned, no subsidy (2.5%) and friends/family permanent (3.5%) each account for less than 10% of total ES exits, however, they are graphically represented on the map to show the low number of ES exits to permanent housing.)
- ⁴ Category **Other II. Other Destinations (409)** combines the following destination types in Data Element 3.12: Staying with friends or family (temporary tenure), Hotel or motel, Deceased, or Other.
